Some of our programs include: Adoption and Receiving, Wildlife Rescue and Release, two Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Clinics, Cruelty Investigations, Humane Education, Popcorn Park Zoo, and publication of HUMANE NEWS, ZoonooZ, and other animal welfare literature.

If you decide to make provisions in your Will for the future care of your pets, the following wording should be included: *“I leave the Associated Humane Societies \$ \_\_\_\_\_ (money, real estate, life insurance, stocks, annuity, etc.). I also leave \_\_\_\_\_ dogs and/or \_\_\_\_\_ cats and/or \_\_\_\_\_ (other animals) for lifetime care at the Society’s Forked River Animal Care Center”.*

It is critical that both sentences be separate and distinct. Once you have made that decision, it is important that you notify the Society in advance of your wishes and also provide a copy of that page from your Will stating your intentions. We will then send you wallet cards and decals for your home in the event of an emergency or your incapacitation. We will also send you health history forms for each pet requesting that you give us the pet,s name, age, diet, health problems, spay/neuter and the name of your veterinarian.

We will also include in the packet a special emergency telephone number that is manned 24 hours a day. These steps will enable us to provide the best care possible for your pet and make their transition as comfortable as possible. If you live in the area, we’d love for you to stop by and see this special animal care facility, and experience the warmth, love and tranquility that Kitty and Animal Haven provides.
